

EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY REGISTER, Family Services and Welfare Department

Mille Lacs County Family Services and Welfare Department positions are hired through the Minnesota Merit System. The Minnesota Merit System announces civil service examinations for employment in the social services and human services agencies in 75 of Minnesota's 87 counties.

Many Merit System position examinations are open for application on a continuous basis; others are open only when a specific vacancy is being filled. Applications for positions that are not currently open for application will be held by the Merit System until that position is announced, or for one year, whichever comes first. Currently the following examinations are always open for application because there are frequently vacancies available in these job classifications throughout the State. (This abbreviated list includes positions that are hired by Mille Lacs County.)

It is not necessary for you to contact Mille Lacs County to apply for Family Services and Welfare Department positions. When a vacancy arises in the Mille Lacs County Family Services and Welfare Department, we notify Merit System and they send us a register (a list) to use that includes names, addresses, phone numbers, exam scores, and completed employment applications. If you are selected as a finalist, Mille Lacs County will contact you to schedule an interview appointment. Salary and benefit information are provided by the County Coordinator's office when an interview appointment is scheduled.
